- 1. Every paper must be accompanied by a cover page, which should include the title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s) and their affiliations, resident country and the complete postal.
- The Research Papers should be in a Word Document format, Times New Roman, 12- point font size with 1.5 line spacing, 1 inch margins and APA style of referencing.
- 3. The Word Limit for the Research Paper is limited to 4500 words, and must include the following: Title, Objectives of the study, Methodology, Findings, Conclusion/Implications/ Recommendations. Limitations (if any), Acknowledgements (if appropriate), References, Appendices (if appropriate).
- 4. Abstracts should be limited to 350 words.
- 5. The Institute has a strict anti-plagiarism policy, therefore, the authors must ensure originality of the work. Selected candidates will be informed through mail.
